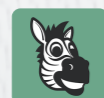

Organic Waste and Compostable Bioplastics

Use the provided bin and compostable bags for disposal.



Food scraps / Fruit and vegetables
Meat and fish scraps / Pasta / Bread
Coffee grounds / Tea filters / Eggshells
Cut flowers / Cold wood ashes
Cork stoppers / Compostable baking paper
Compostable tableware and cutlery
Compostable bioplastic packaging



Non-organic materials
(e.g. containers, cans, jars and bottles, liquids)
Traditional plastic bags / Diapers
Chewing gum / Pet Litter / Cigarette butts
Non-compostable baking paper



Residual Waste

Use the provided bin with semi-transparent bags for disposal. Black garbage bags are not allowed.



Rubber items / Synthetic sponges
Plastic cutlery / Plastic straws
Cigarette butts / Dust / Receipts
Greaseproof paper / Disposable gloves
Wet wipes / Broken plates and glasses

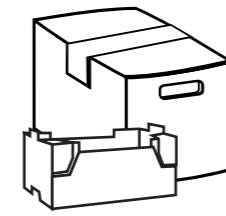


Recyclable materials
(paper, plastic, compostable bioplastic, glass, metals, organic waste)
Textile waste / Small WEEE / Used cooking oil
Hazardous, toxic, and harmful waste



Cardboard packaging

To be disposed of without any bag



Cardboard packaging



Expose cardboard boxes properly flattened to reduce their volume.

Plastic, Steel and Aluminium



Bottles / Containers / Food packaging
Polystyrene / Vegetable bags
Trays and fruit nets / Tins
Beverage cans / Metal caps and lids
Oil cans / Aluminium tubes / Food jars
Aluminium trays and foil



Materials other than those listed
Paper and cardboard
Paint, solvent and acid containers (marked T/F)
Rubber items / Plastic and metal pipes
Compostable bioplastic packaging



Paper

Use the provided bin and paper bags (or without) for disposal.



Newspapers / Magazines
Beverage and food cartons (juices, pasta, rice)
Cleaning and hygiene product cartons (soaps)
Paper and cardboard bags and boxes
Cardboard packaging



Greaseproof paper / Thermal paper (receipts)
Laminated paper / Compostable baking paper
Any paper or cardboard soiled with paints or similar substances



Glass

Use the provided bin with no-bags for disposal.



Glass bottles / Glass jars
(All glass containers must be disposed of without caps)



Oven dishes / Crystal, ceramic, porcelain and earthenware items (plates, cups, etc.)
Glass sheets / Drinking glasses / Mirrors
Light bulbs and neon lamps
Demijohns and other bulky items
